Well, then I arrived at the first of September and my first experience was that I almost lost my return ticket to Germany and my money. I would have been stuck with you then, my whole life!

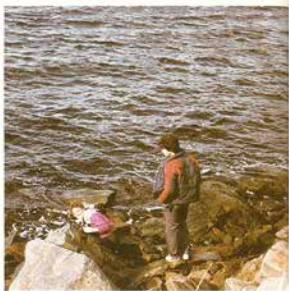
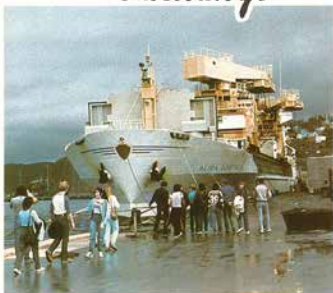

"Tschüß B" (Bye)

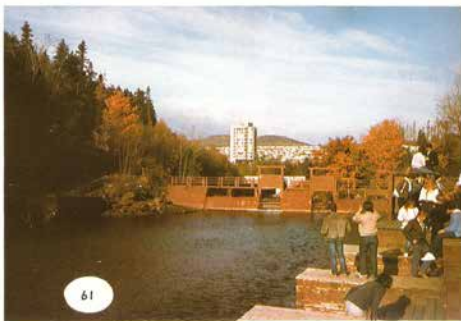

All in all, the Flin Flon School's Band had a busy and successful year!





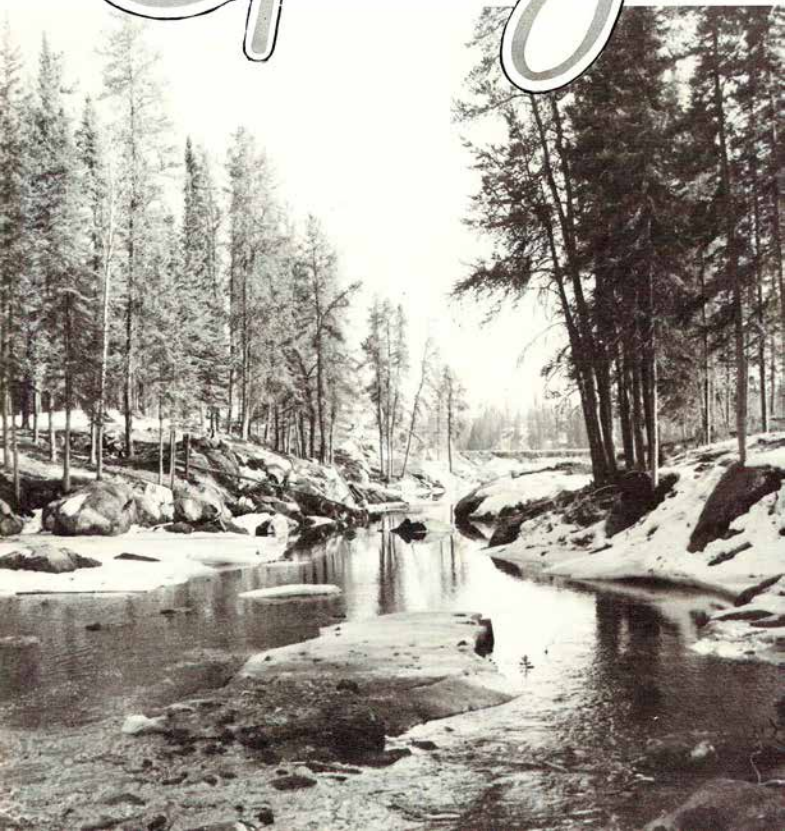
# TRAVEL CLUB

The tour began when the students arrived in Frankfurt, Germany on the 25th. There they picked up their tour guides and travelled a day to Wurzburg, Germany where they toured the fortress of Reimburg. Leaving Reimburg, the tour then continued down the Romantic Road to Munich where the students stopped at one point along the way to visit the ancient walled city of Rothenburg. Once there they toured the city. In Munich, the "Bavarian Evening" stands out as a special memory, complete with yodelling, music, food and period clothing.

The mood changed drastically when the group encountered famed war camp, Dachau. The experience was pretty somber, complete with crematoriums and museums depicting graphic scenes from the horror of the camp that once was Dachau. Another unique stop along the way was Berchtesgaden, in the Bavarian Alps where the students visited the salt mines, and got to view Hitler's final retreat high upon a mountainside. One of the best experiences was the visit to Innsbruck where in sunny above-zero temperatures, the students got to ski down the women's Olympic ski trail,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  kms. long and boasting a sheer 800-meter vertical drop. Before trip's end, other stops included Hauptbahnhof Street, "one of the most expensive shopping streets in the world, and banking centre of the world." The next day students visited the Black Forest and stopped at Heidelberg before preparing for the final trip homeward.
